Rodney Strong “Chalk Hill Vineyard” Chardonnay, Sonoma, California	46.75
<i>This wine has nice lemon-cream, nectarine and pear flavors with tropical and mineral touches.</i>		
Sonoma–Cutrer “Russian River Ranches” Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, California	49.75
<i>Winemaker Terry Adams says “ Very pretty aromas of jasmine and rose petal come quickly back to more expected tropical fruits like pineapple, mango and a bit of pear. This wine is medium weight, clean with a wonderful acid backbone and it expands from your first sip to your last, offering flavors of citrus, grapefruit, lemon, pear and vanilla. - Robert Mondavi, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** 59.75
This Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon unfolds in deep, dense layers of blackberry, black plum, cassis and a hint of cedar. These expressive flavors come from the diverse soil and climates of vineyards located primarily in the Oakville and Stags Leap District.
- Louis M. Martini, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** (88* The Wine Advocate) 47.75
This Napa Valley wine possesses a dark ruby-purple color, as well as a big, rich nose of black currant, loamy soil, and freshly cut lawn scents. Flavors of ripe red fruits, cassis, sweet herbs,.....a medium body and firm structure.
- Beaulieu Vineyard "Rutherford" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** 55.75
This wine has a deep ruby red color to match its concentrated fruit flavors of cassis, blackberry, and cherry.
- Rutherford Ranch, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California** 45.75
Abounds in soft and seductive fragrances of freshly picked blackberries, black currants and rich mocha undertones with a long finish.
- Stag's Leap, Merlot, Napa Valley, California** (89* The Wine Advocate) 63.75
Here's the real deal in a sumptuous, elegant and complex Merlot from a venerable Napa Producer. Fully dry, this has deeply earthy blackberry, rum and cola flavors that are wrapped in fine, ripely sweet tannins.
- McWilliam's, Merlot, Coonawarra, New South Wales, Australia** 39.75
Gold Metals,!. Silver Metals!.. McWilliams is considered to be one of Australia's most highly respected family-owned wine makers. Their Merlot has a deep ruby hue, a mixed bouquet of berry, menthol, vanilla and bell pepper scents. Generous sweet cherry flavors.
- Blackstone "Sonoma Reserve" Merlot, Sonoma Valley, California** 49.75
This Reserve Merlot offers pleasing aromas of fresh raspberry, black currant, clove and vanilla with a hint of earthiness. The wine is full-bodied with layers of bright red fruit, coffee and clove, finished with a nice, well- integrated structure and a velvety mouth feel.
- Rancho Zabaco, Red Zinfandel, Sonoma County, California** 43.75
This Zinfandel is exuberantly robust and full of spice –the kind of taste that makes Zin lovers smileand say "Wow! "
- Gloria Ferrer, Pinot Noir, Carneros, California** (Every vintage wins "Gold" awards, year after year) 75.75
Made from seven distinct Pinot Noir clones, this wine showcases the diversity of these Sonoma County estate vineyards. Flavors of ripe cherry and berry fruits...with hints of smoke, bacon and earth that all lead to a long silky finish.
- Rodney Strong "Russian River" Pinot Noir, Sonoma Valley, California** 61.75
An earthy, spicy nose opens up to aromas of rose petal and cherry. Full-bodied with rich concentrated berry and smoked cherry flavors.
- Wolf Blass "Presidents Selection" Shiraz, South Australia** (89 Points – The Wine Enthusiast) 45.75
A solid Shiraz that offers refined scents of wood shavings, black currants and caramel. This is a wine with admirable purity of flavor, the blackberry and cassis fruit cleanly framed by vanilla-laden oak.If you like Shiraz , you will enjoy this one !
- Bridlewood Estate Winery "Central Coast" Syrah, Santa Barbara, California** 55.75
The Bridlewood Estate is constantly winning awards for their Syrah. The wine is balanced with a full palate and generous texture that highlights the complexity and elegance of Syrah.
- Masi, Modello Delle Venezie Rosso, The Venetian Territories of Italy** 47.75
Bright red color of medium intensity. Ripe fruit on the nose, with particular hints of bitter cherries. Attractively fresh on the palate and unexpectedly weighty; plumped out with soft tannins that are perfectly blended in..... Perfect with any of our Pasta dishes !
- Da Vinci, Chianti, D.O.C.G., Tuscany, Italy** (87* – The Wine Spectator) 37.75
The deep and wonderful crimson color.....the aromas of cherries and red fruit which are all balanced by the round tannins. Now we know why the Wine Spectator loves this wine !
- Tenuta Di Nozzole, Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany, Italy** 54.75
This full-fruited, supple yet well-structured wine shows crisp, ripe red berry and cherry fruit flavors and aromas sustained by a fresh, acidic note offset by classic Sangiovese notes of earth, mushrooms and leather, with an elegant tannic backbone.
- Castello Di Querceto, Chianti Classico Riserva, Tuscany, Italy** (90* – The Wine Spectator) 57.75
Wonderful perfumes of chocolate, berry and raspberry follow through to a full-bodied palate, with firm tannins and a long, refreshing finish. This Chianti has just received a 90 score from the Wine Spectator. Enjoy !

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
